

ID: IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of or 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 s, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for advice. KIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately enty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

LLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting told to do so by poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by to an unconscious person. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is athing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further ent advice.
